Merciless murder of an Iranian ex-refugee in Iran.

While the human rights organizations warn about the new policies regarding deportation of refugees to their home country, news were received that an Iranian refugee who was forcibly sent back to Iran, has been murdered.

According to Gooya news site, Mr. Ismael Yusefi, who was deported to Iran six weeks ago, was killed in Iran. A month ago, only two weeks after deportation to Iran, his body was found with signs of torture and wounds all over.

Ten international human rights organizations declared that the new immigration policies 2089, 438 and 928, which are going to be examined by the European Union, were against the basic rights of refugees and international law. They added that the real meaning of these rules is that refugees could be deported to their home countries, which will endanger their lives.
